Mayor Sven Weigt visits INTEC Engineering GmbH – discussion about the future and growth prospects

As part of his visits to local businesses, Bruchsal's mayor Sven Weigt and business development officer Birgit Welge visited INTEC Engineering GmbH to get to know the company and discuss current developments and possible expansion prospects at the site.

INTEC designs, manufactures and supplies industrial process heat and power generation systems worldwide. With its high level of technical expertise and around 100 employees, it makes an important contribution to the economic strength of the Bruchsal region.

Managing Director Denis Karrer, his brother Christoph Karrer and company founder Edwin Karrer gave the guests a comprehensive insight into production, development, core competencies and current projects. Weigt and Welge were particularly

impressed by the high level of vertical integration and innovative strength with which INTEC responds to the requirements of modern industrial processes.

The subsequent discussion focused on expansion and development opportunities at the site. Topics such as the shortage of skilled workers, infrastructure, public transport and energy-efficient connections were also discussed. Weigt and Welge agreed to examine suitable framework conditions for future growth plans.

‘Direct communication with our companies is particularly important to us,’ emphasised Mayor Weigt. ‘Only through dialogue can we learn about the opportunities and challenges that exist – and where the city can actively provide support.’

Managing Director Denis Karrer was delighted with the city's interest: ‘We greatly appreciate the good cooperation with Bruchsal. It is important to know that our concerns are being heard and that we can work together on sustainable solutions.’

The company celebrated its 30th anniversary at its Bruchsal location in 2025.
